

Grant proposal: We are looking for funding for our new club "The Path".

The purpose of the club is to educate 9-12th graders who are interested in 4 year colleges as to what they need to do to be prepared for the admissions process. We will concentrate on the need for a well-rounded individual. Community service, test prep and knowing what the admission requirements are so that when they become 12th graders they are not realizing things they need -needed to be done as early as 9th and 10th grade. The club will serve a mentoring role throughout their high school years assisting them with test prep and essay writing for both applications and scholarships.

The funding will be used for paying SAT and ACT test fees for promising underclassman who cannot afford the fees. Currently they can only get fee waivers as 12th graders and some deadlines are as early as October. This does not allow them multiple attempts, where evidence shows the more they take the test, the better they do. We hope to get them to test as 9th and 10th graders.
